


This includes donations from individuals as general donations and also restricted donations to Young Artists Scholarships, Music Education, Music Library Fund, and also Concert Sponsors. In the 2022/2023 fiscal year, the Festival returned a modest operating surplus thanks to community support and foundation grants. A 10-year Long Range Plan was adopted which includes taking the recommended annual distribution from our endowment funds managed by Oregon Community Foundation and maintaining a stable reserve fund. We are in a positive position to carry forward funds and steward donations received for their intended purpose.


